What Kind of Work is this?

- Physical mobility needed
- Test, inspect, repair and maintain fire alarms

Entry requirements:

- Grade 12 math and reading or equivalent
- 18 years old

Requirements to become registered

- 5 theory courses, 36 hours each
- Can be completed in **10 weekends**
- register as trainee with Canadian Fire Alarm Association (CFAA) (\$80)
- pass CFAA Registration Theory Exam (\$180) and Practical Exam (\$425)
- 1500 hours of fire alarm work experience recommended.
